INTERSPUTNIK'S STRUCTURE

Board

(Governments of Member Countries)

- Definition of the general policy and long-term goals;
- Making sure that the Organization's activity complies with the purposes and principles of the UN Charter;
- Decision-making based on recommendations of the Operations Committee.

Operations Committee (Signatories)

- Definition of the commercial, technological and financial policy;
- Definition of the amounts of the Share Capital and dividends.

Directorate (Director General, staff)

- Making sure that decisions of the Board and Operations Committee are fulfilled;
- Organization of the operation and development of the Intersputnik system;
- Current operations.

Implementation of satellite projects using orbit and spectrum resource filed with the ITU on Intersputnik's behalf.



Cooperation with ABS in using satellite capacity in Intersputnik's orbital positions.






