



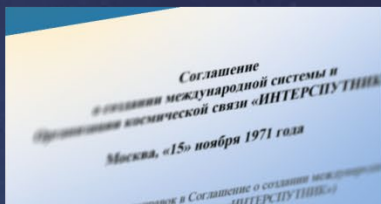

## INTERNATIONAL LEGAL STATUS OF INTERSPUTNIK

Intersputnik's international legal status is governed by the following international treaties:

**Intersputnik Agreement** of November 15, 1971 registered with the UN Secretariat on March 27, 1973 under No. 12343

**Protocol** of November 30, 1996 **on Amendments to the Intersputnik Agreement**

**Agreement** of September 20, 1976 **on the Legal Capacity, Privileges and Immunities**

**Agreement** of September 15, 1977 **on the Settlement of Issues Related to the Seat of the Organization** in the Russian Federation

**Operating Agreement** of February 4, 2003 having the status of an international interagency treaty

The Depository of Intersputnik's international treaties is the Government of the Russian Federation represented by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

## INTERSPUTNIK'S STRUCTURE

**Board**  
(Governments  
of Member Countries)

- Definition of the general policy and long-term goals;
- Making sure that the Organization's activity complies with the purposes and principles of the UN Charter;
- Decision-making based on recommendations of the Operations Committee.

**Operations Committee**  
(Signatories)

- Definition of the commercial, technological and financial policy;
- Definition of the amounts of the Share Capital and dividends.

**Directorate**  
(Director General, staff)

- Making sure that decisions of the Board and Operations Committee are fulfilled;
- Organization of the operation and development of the Intersputnik system;
- Current operations.

Implementation of satellite projects using orbit and spectrum resource filed with the ITU on Intersputnik's behalf.



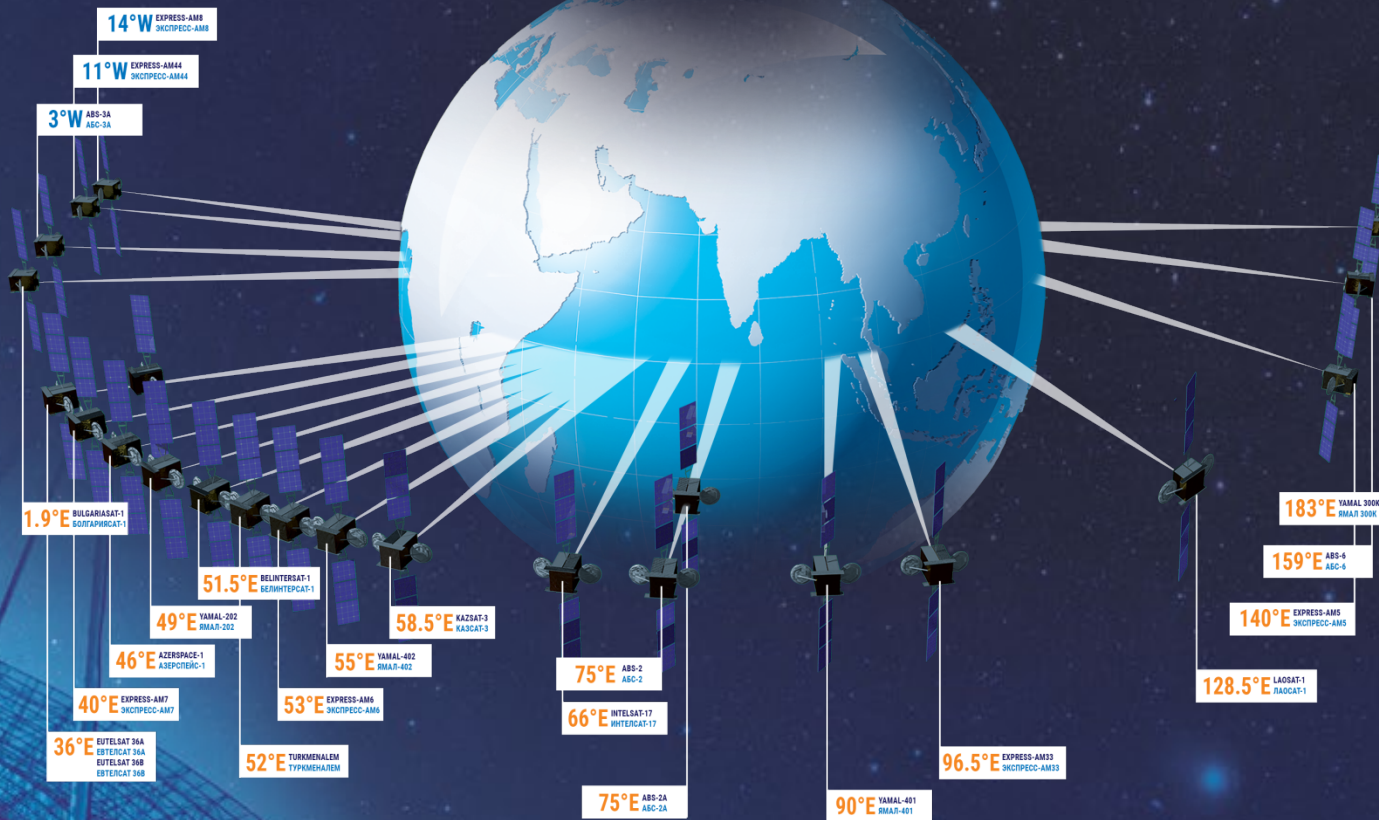

Cooperation with **ABS** in using satellite capacity in Intersputnik's orbital positions.

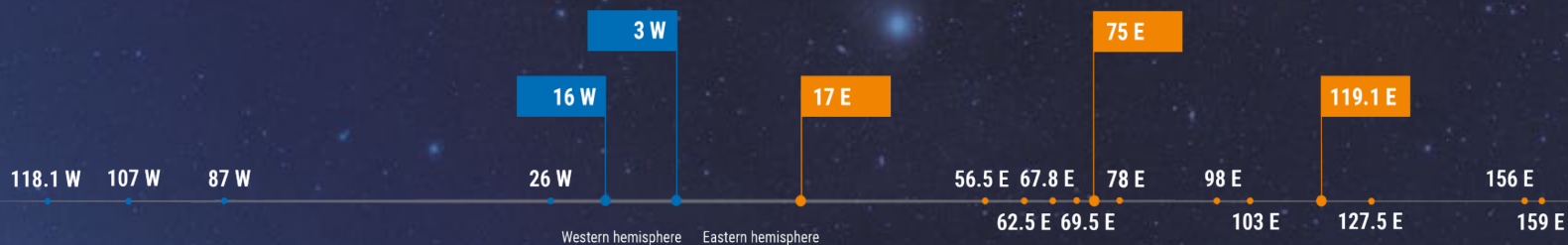
